- ask tour operator for specifics on responsible travel
- ask tour operator how you could help out in the local community
- buy local produces
- respect the local culture, traditions, holy places



- use public transport, bike, or walk when convenient, great way to meet locals
- locals have different views on things, ask more questions rather than judging

When you get back

- give feedback to tour operators about the trip, include suggestions and comments
- send pictures or gifts back to the local people you remember
- enjoy your memories and plan your next trip
